SPOON AWARD DEFINITIONS:

Category I & II Gold Spoon:

Awarded for no priority violations, no more than 1 priority foundation violation, and excellence in training of Certified Food Protection. Managers and food handler staff at the required levels at all times.

Category III Gold Spoon:

Awarded to retail establishments with no food preparation that had no violations observed at time of annual inspection.

Category I & II Silver Spoon:

Awarded to establishments with food preparation for excellence in training of food manager staff.

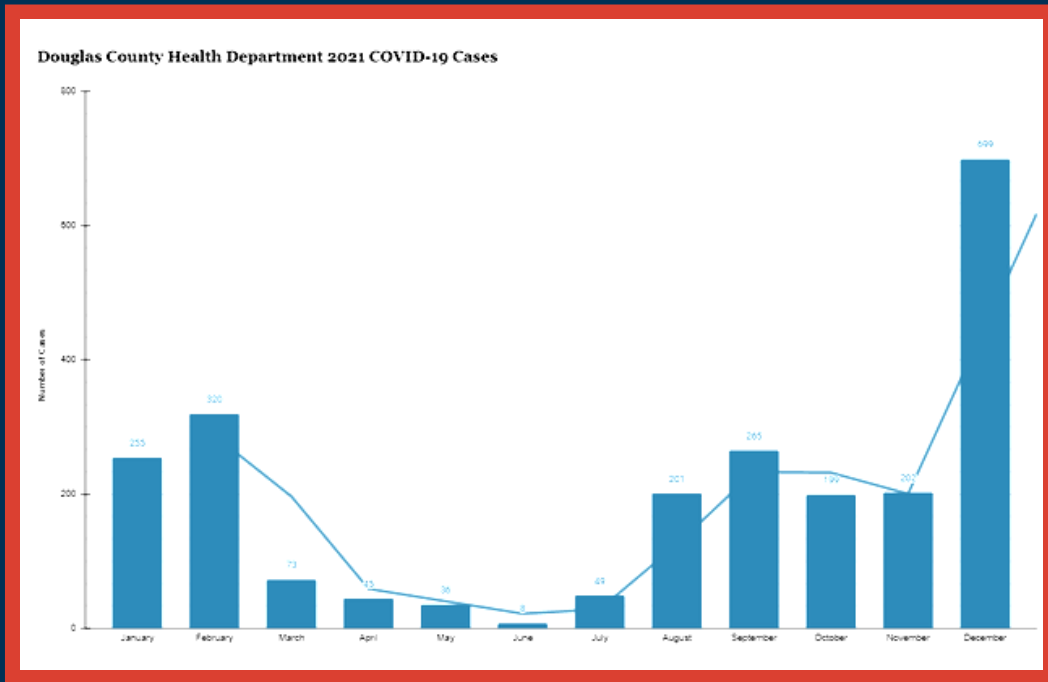
Category III Silver Spoon:

Awarded to retail establishments with no food preparation at which no priority level violations observed at time of annual inspection.

TOP 3 DOCUMENTED VIOLATIONS:

1. Physical facilities installed, maintained, and clean.
2. Food and non-food contact surfaces cleanable, properly designed, constructed, and used
3. Non-food contact surfaces clean
